

Announcement to Contributors

The INTERNATIONAL JOURNAL OF LEPROSY and Other Mycobacterial Diseases is devoted to the publication of original articles, selected printed articles, editorials, correspondence, news items, abstracts, reviews, and other material of interest to leprosy workers.

Original articles are accepted only on condition that they have not been published elsewhere, and *will not be published elsewhere before appearance* in THE JOURNAL. An article that has appeared in THE JOURNAL may be reprinted elsewhere, provided proper reference to its original source is given.

Submission of manuscripts. Manuscripts are to be submitted in triplicate (original and two copies or photoduplicates), typewritten and double-spaced on folio size paper 8 1/2 x 11 inches (21 x 27 cm) with 1 1/2 inch margins on left, top, and bottom. Full names of all authors of each manuscript, their academic and medical degrees and administrative positions must be included with each manuscript. Most manuscripts can and should be divided into the following sections: Introduction, Materials and Methods, Results, Discussion, Summary, Acknowledgments, References, Tables, and Illustration Legends. *References* are to be typed on a separate page in alphabetical order according to first author and numbered consecutively with their corresponding numbers in the text. In the references full names of all authors, complete title (in original language), name of journal (names are abbreviated according to *Index Medicus*), and volume with year and first and last pages of article must be listed. Book references must have author(s) name, title of article and/or book, place and name of publisher, year of publication, and page numbers. *Illustrations.* Three sets are needed. Only glossy prints are accepted (photo and/or charts). The number of illustrations that can be used without charge to the author is limited to four. Illustrations in excess of this number will be charged to the author. Pictures will be reproduced only in black and white, unless authors arrange to meet the expense of color work. Each illustration must be accompanied by a short descriptive legend.

Reprints. *No free separates are supplied to authors.* At the time of pagination, the printer, Allen Press, will send order forms to authors, noting the number of pages, giving a table listing cost of reprints, and furnishing other pertinent information.

The INTERNATIONAL JOURNAL OF LEPROSY and Other Mycobacterial Diseases is issued quarterly, one volume annually. Subscriptions are for full volume only.

Membership in the International Leprosy Association: Membership dues are US \$40.00 annually and include subscription to THE JOURNAL (no discounts are given to agencies; if the latter are used, agency costs must be covered in such manner that THE JOURNAL receives the full \$40.00 for each membership). **Subscription for nonmembers:** Effective with Volume 47, 1979, the subscription price is US \$60.00 payable (exclusive of agency charges) in advance. Single numbers of the current volume are US \$15.00 post paid. Prices for back issues depend upon availability and can be determined by correspondence with the Executive Officer (New Jersey address). If current copies are lost in the mails, notice should be given promptly to the New Jersey office. When copies are available, replacement will be made without charge.
