

## Announcement to Contributors

The *INTERNATIONAL JOURNAL OF LEPROSY AND OTHER MYCOBACTERIAL DISEASES* is devoted to original articles, editorials, correspondence, and material of interest to leprosy.

Original articles not published elsewhere in *THE JOURNAL*. Any article published elsewhere, provided it has not been published elsewhere, is accepted on condition that it be reprinted in *THE JOURNAL* at the discretion of the Editor.

**Submission of Manuscripts.** Manuscripts are to be submitted in triplicate (original and two carbon copies), typewritten and double-spaced on folio size paper 8½ × 11 inches (21 × 27 cm) with 1½ inch margins. Full names and addresses of all authors of each manuscript, their degrees and administrative positions must be included. Most manuscripts should be divided into the following sections: Introduction, Materials and Methods, Results, Discussion, Summary, Acknowledgments, References, Tables, and Illustration Legends. *References* are to be typed on a separate page in alphabetical order according to first author and numbered consecutively with their corresponding numbers in the text. In the references full names of all authors, complete title (in original language), name of journal (names are abbreviated according to *Index Medicus*), and volume with year and first and last pages of article must be listed. Book references must have author(s) name, title of article and/or book, place and name of publisher, year of publication, and page numbers. *Illustrations.* Three sets are needed. Only glossy prints are accepted (photo and/or charts). The number of illustrations that can be used without charge to the author is limited to four. Illustrations in excess of this number will be charged to the author. Pictures will be reproduced only in black and white, unless authors arrange to meet the expense of color work. Each illustration must be accompanied by a short descriptive legend.

**Reprints.** No free separates are supplied to authors. At the time of pagination, the printer, Allen Press, will send order forms to authors, noting the number of pages, giving a table listing cost of reprints, and furnishing other pertinent information.
